

LHPB Club Proposal



Create and implement a club rating system to provide accurate and consistent ratings for skill-based club events for those members without a USAPA (USA Pickleball Association) ranking.



Current System Pre 2021

- players have option to enter USAPA rating, self-rating or leave blank on the LHPB website
- members can change self-rating score based on desired participation in skill-based events
- members have a tendency to compare skill with other members and adopt their rating

Why do we need a club rating system?

Provide accurate and consistent sign-ups for the following:

- club instructional classes
- club tournaments
- skill-based club events

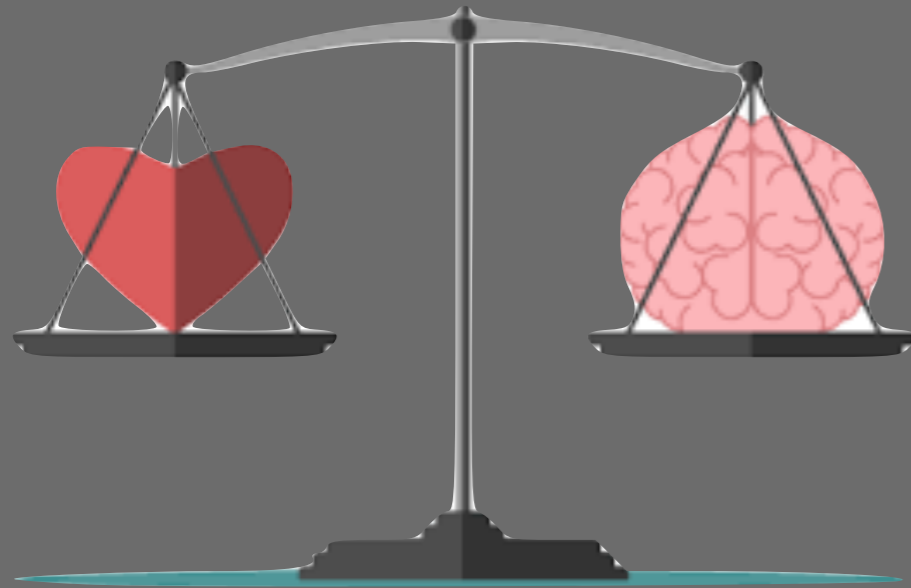


Not applicable for ladder sign ups until June 2021

Who will be eligible for club rating?



- members without a USAPA rating
- members who are interested in participating in instructional classes, club tournaments and skilled based events
- **note:** members are **NOT** required to have a club rating to play pickleball



The Benefits

- consistency of rating
- identify what you need to work on for improvement
- provide focused skill instruction
- opportunities to re-rate

The Process



Assessment Team

1. team members have skills in analysis and experience in collecting data
2. team members will complete approximately 20 hours of training from a rating specialist on administering assessments without bias using objective, consistent, and fair tools
3. team members will complete practice rating assessment sessions to ensure consistent and quality outcomes
4. team members will be periodically evaluated for accuracy

Assessment Tools



- carefully designed assessment tools guided by our rating specialist and a variety of local and national resources
- assessment tools include knowledge quiz, skill level expectations, skill-based tests, and game evaluation
- members will have access to all assessment tools and video demonstration in preparation of the rating session on the club website

Establish guidelines and procedures for rating system

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1. offer rating clinics at least once a month
 2. provide online video of assessment
 3. members will have the opportunity to ask for clarification and discuss their rating with their Assessment Team
 4. member must wait 60 days to re-test
