PICKLEBALL COURT COVID PROTOCOLS (Updated April 1, 2021)

The following rules numbered 1 through 4 have been established by the Sun City Lincoln Hills Community Association, and must be adhered to by all residents using the Lincoln Hills pickleball courts.

Players are expected to follow these protocols whenever they are on the courts. All players are encouraged to respectfully remind others of these rules as appropriate. Pickleball Club Board members will periodically observe those at the courts to ensure these protocols remain effective. If non-residents appear at the courts and do not immediately leave when requested to do so, any player may call the Association's Curator security service and let them handle the situation; the phone number is 916-771-7185.

1. Non-residents, including guests, are not allowed on the courts.
2. Wear your mask to and from the courts. Masks are not required during play.
3. Maintain appropriate social distancing at all times.
4. Prepare to leave your court five minutes before your reservation is over, to allow safe entry to the court for the next group of players.

The following are suggestions for Lincoln Hills pickleball players. They are not part of the COVID Protocols, and will not be enforced by the Association, but are worthy of your serious consideration.

1. Sanitize your ball and paddle after use.
2. Consider self-quarantine for 7 days before playing in Lincoln Hills if in your judgment you are at risk of having contracted the coronavirus. This risk may be due to the following:
 - Travel out of the area
 - Attendance at a large indoor gathering
 - Feeling any symptoms or are awaiting COVID test results
